A staff member with Covid-19 received your support

One Wycliffe Canada staff member contracted Covid-19 in her country of assignment and still has not completely recovered. When it was determined that she was not contagious, and a flight became available, she returned to Canada. "It has cost way more than I expected to get to Canada," she said. "As I look at the cost of living in Alberta for the year as well as set up costs (a car, warm clothes, groceries, etc.) I know it's going to be an expensive year."

Family's medical costs reduced, making a return to the field possible

One family experienced health issues and had to use up their savings to pay for medical procedures and prescriptions not covered by provincial health care. Your gifts to the Emergency Fund covered some of these costs. Without this financial provision, this family's return to the field would have been delayed indefinitely.



Recent Highlights

- Provided support for staff exhibiting stress and needing counselling. Up to 20 staff were able to receive help in this way.
- Paid for evacuation or other Covid-related costs for six staff families.
- Supported three families dealing with financial crises.



Upcoming Goals

- Continue to help staff who are now returning to the field but have to pay for more expensive flights or quarantine costs upon arrival.
- Continue to provide up to 50% of the cost of counselling sessions for staff needing professional support.
- Continue to assist members as emergencies arise. A number of additional applications for funding have been received.
- Continue to distribute funds to members affected by Covid-19, whether related to health, travel, or financial stress.
